IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Call the emergency services on 111.
Spill or leak	Use appropriate protective equipment. Clear area of unnecessary personnel. Spills should be cleaned up immediately. Large Spill: Contain and recover as much as possible to a salvage container. Do not allow product or run-off to enter waterways or drains.
Fire	Call the Fire Service on 111. Self-contained breathing apparatus required. Smoke may be toxic. Do not allow contaminated run-off to enter drains.

FIRST AID 24 HOUR ADVICE IN A FIRST AID EMERGENCY 0800 POISON (0800 764 766)

If swallowed	DO NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water. Contact National Poisons Centre on 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor for advice.
If in eyes	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing for at least 15 minutes. Get medical attention if irritation persists.
If on skin	If skin contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and wash skin with soap and water. If irritation or rash persists, get medical attention.
If inhaled	Move person to fresh air immediately and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice if person feels unwell.
