STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR EMERGENCY ADVICE CALL 0800 CHEMCALL (0800 243 622)

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Call the emergency services on 111.
Spill or leak	Wear chemical resistant: coveralls, respiratory protection (Organic Vapour specification minimum) gloves, boots and safety goggles. Prevent further spillage. Absorb spilled product and place in sealable container for disposal. Wash down affected area with water plus detergent. Absorb and collect washings and place in the same sealable container for disposal. Seek advice from the local authority regarding disposal.
Fire	Call the Fire Service: Dial 111. Wear PVC protective clothing and breathing apparatus. Extinguish fires with foam, dry chemical or carbon dioxide. During a fire toxic fumes may be released. Cool sealed drums with water to prevent rupture due to thermal expansion. Contain run-off. Keep non-involved persons away.

If swallowed	DO NOT induce vomiting. For advice contact the National Poisons Centre 0800 POISON (0800 764 766) or a doctor immediately.
If in eyes	Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists: get medical advice/attention.
If on skin	If skin or hair contact occurs, remove contaminated clothing and flush skin and hair with running water. Do not scrub the skin.
If inhaled	Remove patient to fresh air. If not breathing, give artificial respiration, preferably mouth-to-nose. Get immediate medical attention if symptoms develop.
