STORAGE AND SEGREGATION

Storage: Store in the closed original container in a cool, dry, well-ventilated and secure area, out of direct sunlight, when not in use. Store locked up. Keep out of reach of children. Keep away from food and feedstuffs. Store in accordance with the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals.

EMERGENCY PROCEDURES FOR EMERGENCY ADVICE CALL 0800 CHEMCALL (0800 243 622)

IF THIS HAPPENS	DO THIS
Tanker/Vehicle Accident	Switch off engine and electrical equipment. Keep people away, warn other traffic. Call the emergency services on 111.
Spill or leak	Use appropriate protective equipment. Clear area of unnecessary personnel. Spills should be cleaned up immediately. Large Spill: Contain and recover as much as possible to a salvage container. Do not allow product or run-off to enter waterways or drains.
Fire	Call the Fire Service on 111. Not a fire or explosion hazard. Self-contained breathing apparatus required. Hydrogen chloride gas may be formed during a fire. Do not allow contaminated run-off to enter drains.

FIRST AID 24 HOUR ADVICE IN A FIRST AID EMERGENCY 0800 POISON (0800 764 766)

If swallowed	DO NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth with water. Contact National Poisons Centre on 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor for advice.
If in eyes	Immediately flush the eye(s) with lukewarm, gently flowing water for at least 15 minutes while holding the eyelids open. Remove contact lenses after the first 5 minutes if present and easy to do, then continue rinsing. Get immediate medical attention.
If on skin	Remove contaminated clothing. Wash affected skin gently and thoroughly with plenty of water and soap. Do not scrub. Get medical attention if irritation occurs. Wash contaminated clothing before re-use.
If inhaled	Move person to fresh air immediately and keep at rest in a position comfortable for breathing. Get medical advice if person feels unwell.
