Safety information

- Use a mask when handling biochar as it contains fine particle matter.
- Biochar can ignite if exposed to heat or flame.
- When burnt, Biochar emits carbon monoxide so should never be burnt in an enclosed environment.
- Gloves recommended when handling as it can stain the skin.

How to use

Applications can be repeated annually, mixed into root zone or blended with your favourite fertiliser to fuel plant growth. For existing crops, it can also be applied as a top dressing. Application rates will vary depending on soil types, vegetation & environment. Please see below for a general application guide:

Use	Description	Application
Garden bed	Planter box, lawn, flower bed	1-5 litres/m ²
Potting medium	Adding biochar as part of a potting mix	10% of mass volume
Compost blend	Blending biochar with your favorite compost blend	10% of mass volume
Garden trees	Planting new trees or dressing existing trees	1-5 litres/m ²
Large horticulture	Large scale applications in horticulture crops	targeted at root growth zones
