ANIMAL SAFETY

Poisonous plants (including but not limited to boxthorn, hemlock, nightshades, ragwort and tutu) may become more palatable after spraying. If concerned that stock may be affected, stock should be kept away from the area until plants have died down.

WITHHOLDING PERIODS

Except for animal safety reasons no withholding period is required when used as directed.

DIRECTIONS FOR USE

Buckshot herbicide is recommended as a spot application for control of scattered brushweeds and broadleaf weeds in areas where spray treatment is impractical or undesirable.

DO NOT USE ON PEAT OR HEAVY CLAY SOILS.

TIME OF APPLICATION

Best results are achieved if Buckshot herbicide is applied when favourable growth conditions exist and particularly when sufficient moisture is present to move Buckshot herbicide from the granule to the soil. Applications outside these times may be less effective.

APPLICATION METHOD

Apply Buckshot granules evenly over the top of the plant and in the case of brushweeds extending out to 30cm beyond the dripline. When treating bushes on steep slopes more granules should be applied on the uphill side, as some downward leaching will occur. This product must be applied in accordance with the New Zealand Standard for the Management of Agrichemicals (NZS 8409).

RECORD KEEPING

STORAGE

DISPOSAL
