QUALIFIED HANDLER: This product must be under the control of a suitably trained handler when it is applied in a wide dispersive manner or used by a commercial contractor. This product must not be used for any purpose or in any manner contrary to this label unless authorised under appropriate legislation.

PRECAUTIONS: Obtain special instructions before use. Do not handle until all safety precautions have been read and understood.

PERSONAL PROTECTION: Avoid contact with skin, eyes, and inhalation of spray mist. When handling, wear eye protection, waterproof gloves, boots, and overalls. Remove protective clothing and wash hands and face thoroughly before meals and after work. Do not eat, drink, or smoke while using. Clean protective clothing and equipment before re-use.

STORAGE: Keep out of reach of children. Store in accordance with the current version of NZS 8409 Management of Agrichemicals. Store in the original container away from sources of ignition in a locked, dry, cool area away from foodstuffs, fertilisers, and seeds. Avoid storage at temperatures below 5°C and above 35°C.

SPILLAGE: Collect spillage. Wear appropriate protective clothing and prevent material from entering waterways. Exclude non-essential people from the area. Contain liquid spills and absorb with inert material such as soil or sand and place in waste containers. Dispose of waste safely in an approved landfill.

DISPOSAL: Avoid contamination of any water supply with chemical or empty container. Follow all local, regional, and national laws and regulations regarding hazardous waste disposal.

Product Disposal: Dispose of this product only by using according to the label directions or if this is not possible alternatively contact Rainbow & Brown for advice. Do not dispose of this product down drains or sewers.

Container Disposal: Triple rinse empty containers and add residue to spray tank. Do not burn containers. Crush or puncture and bury in a suitably approved landfill or through Agrecovery recycling service.

FIRST AID: If medical advice is needed, have product container or label at hand. Call a POISON CENTRE, TEL 0800 POISON (0800 764766) or a doctor.

If exposed or concerned, get medical advice.

IF SWALLOWED: Do NOT induce vomiting. Rinse mouth.

IF ON SKIN: Wash with soap and water.

IF IN EYES: Rinse cautiously with water for several minutes. Remove contact lenses, if present and easy to do. Continue rinsing. If eye irritation persists, get medical attention.

IF INHALED: Immediately move to fresh air and rest. Maintain half upright position if breathing is difficult and get medical assistance.

TRANSPORT: Do not carry this product on a passenger service vehicle.

RECORD KEEPING: Records of use required as described in the current NZS8409 Management of Agrichemicals.

MIXING: Add two thirds of the required quantity of water to the spray tank. With the agitation system going, add the product to the spray tank. Agitate for 3-5 minutes while adding remaining water.

COMPATIBILITY: GA200 is compatible with most commonly used residual herbicides.

GENERAL COMMENTS: GA200 is absorbed into the foliage and green stems of actively growing plants. It is inactive in soil and is not translocated as an active ingredient, so thorough coverage of target weeds is essential to obtain optimal results.

Visual effects of treatment with GA200 occur within 3-10 days. The effect will occur more rapidly under ideal growing conditions.

Rainfall within 2 hours of application may wash the product off the foliage. Rain within 6 hours will reduce efficacy to the point where it may be necessary to reapply the product.

Note: Do not spray in temperatures below 10°C. Avoid contact with green plant parts (including immature bark) of desirable plants as damage may occur. Do not mow or cultivate after treatment until weeds start to die back.

WITHHOLDING PERIOD: 28 days on all crops.
