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Recruit™

A residual insecticide for the control of ants, cluster flies, cockroaches and spiders in domestic, industrial and public health areas.

Recruit™ is compatible with most pest control products and adjuvants such as Sprayfast.

FEATURES	BENEFITS
High quality formulation	90% of the active ingredient particles are smaller than 10 microns in diameter. This very small particle size allows for optimum spray contact and thereby the rapid uptake of the insecticide into the insect.
Fast Knockdown	Kills insects fast, removes the problem quickly
Long Residual	Keeps on killing insects long after spray has dried
Non-Repellent	Insects don't know they are being killed by walking over or landing on the sprayed surface
Water Based	Ease of handling and clean up – odour noticeably lower than EC formulations
Spray Mix stability	Active ingredient particles will never separate and form a cream at the top or bottom of the spray mix
Use on porous surfaces	Works longer than EC formulations on unpainted brick, concrete block, bare timber or fibrous cement

DOMESTIC AND INDUSTRIAL PREMISES

WHERE TO APPLY

Ants – spray nests, trails and around dwellings, drains, trees, concrete paths, exterior walls. Spray trails indoors. Recruit™ is compatible with baiting programmes.

Cluster Fly – Best application time is before cluster flies arrive, pay particular attention to warm north facing wall areas where cluster flies are likely to accumulate, around windows and under the surfait.

Cockroaches – spray cracks and crevices, behind sinks, under appliances, walls, skirting boards. Recruit™ is compatible with baiting programmes.

Flying Insects – spray exposed surfaces where insects may rest.

Spiders – Spray webs and known hiding places and exposed surfaces, especially around outside lights.

Fleas – Floors, carpets, kennels, pet bedding and adjacent walls. Mix with Sumilarv® for long term control.

General information

Recruit™ contains 100gm/L bifenthrin as a suspension concentrate.

Use as a directed spray for surface treatment only.

Residual control of up to 6 weeks may be obtained, depending on the type of treated surface, insect pest and the application rate.

Houses, flats, factories, shops, warehouses, restaurants, meat and dairy processing plants	Ants	Initial treatment: 25ml in 5L of water. Maintenance treatments: 12.5ml in 5L of water
	Cluster fly	50ml in 5L of water
	Cockroaches – German, American and Gisborne cockroach (<i>Drymaplaneta semivitta</i>)	Initial Treatment: 40ml in 5L of water. Maintenance Treatment: 20ml in 5L of water
	Mosquitoes	Initial Treatment: 50ml in 5L of water Maintenance treatment: 25ml in 5L of water
	Common spiders, including white tailed spider	Initial treatment: 25ml in 5L of water Maintenance treatment: 12.5ml in 5L of water

CRITICAL COMMENTS

- Apply as a coarse spray at the rate of 5 litres per 100 square metres or to the point before runoff, which will vary with the nature of the treated surface.
- If different water rates are used according to surface porosity adjust the use rate to provide the same coverage of Recruit™ per square metre, e.g. 5ml per 20 square metres for initial treatment of spiders.
- Recruit™ can be applied with any conventional spray equipment used to control public health pests.

Note: Recruit™ does not provide repellent activity against flies or other flying insects.

If repellent activity is required use Key Delta™ Aqua, Key Beta™, KB40™ or Home Run™.
